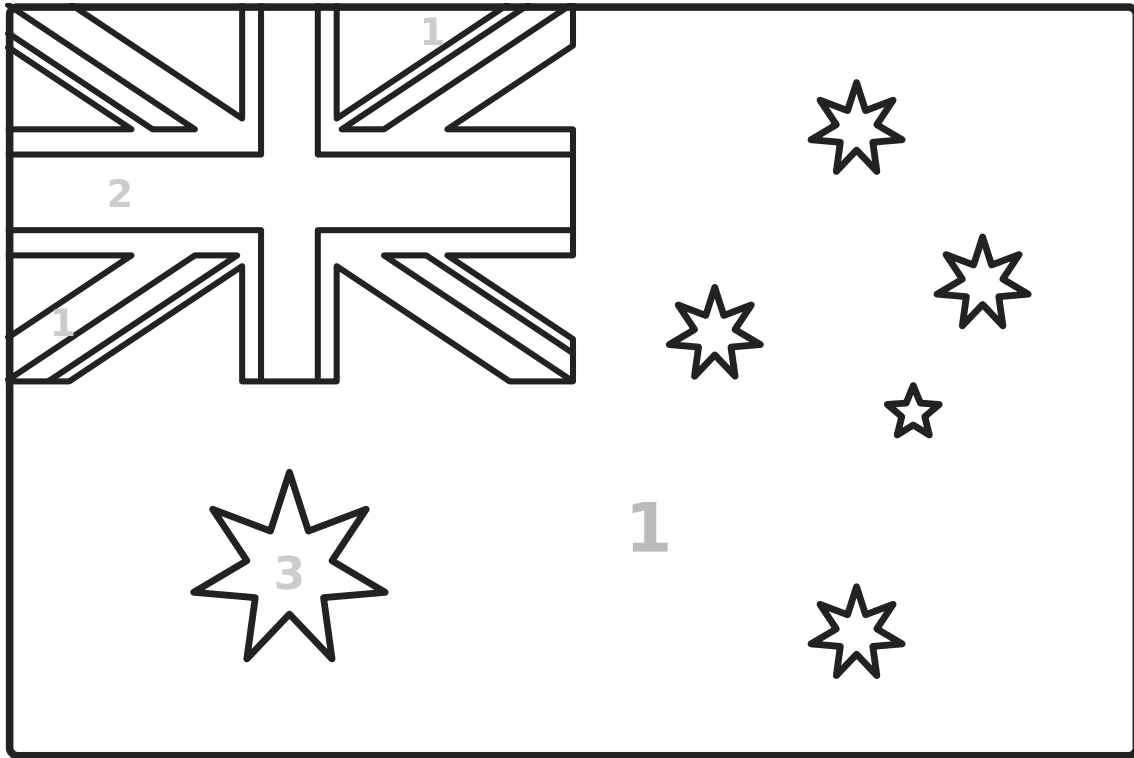


Australia Flag Colouring Page

COLOUR GUIDE

- 1**  **Dark blue** The whole background, and the four corner sections inside the small flag
- 2**  **Red** The upright cross and the diagonal stripes in the small flag
- 3**  **White** The narrow bands around the red crosses, and all six stars

DID YOU KNOW?

The big star under the Union Jack is the **Commonwealth Star**. It has seven points — one for each of the six states, and one for the territories.

The five stars on the right are the **Southern Cross**, a constellation you can only see from the southern half of the world.

Look closely — four of the Southern Cross stars have **seven points**, but the small one has only **five**.

Australia is the only country that is also a **continent**, and it's home to animals found nowhere else, like kangaroos, koalas and platypuses.
