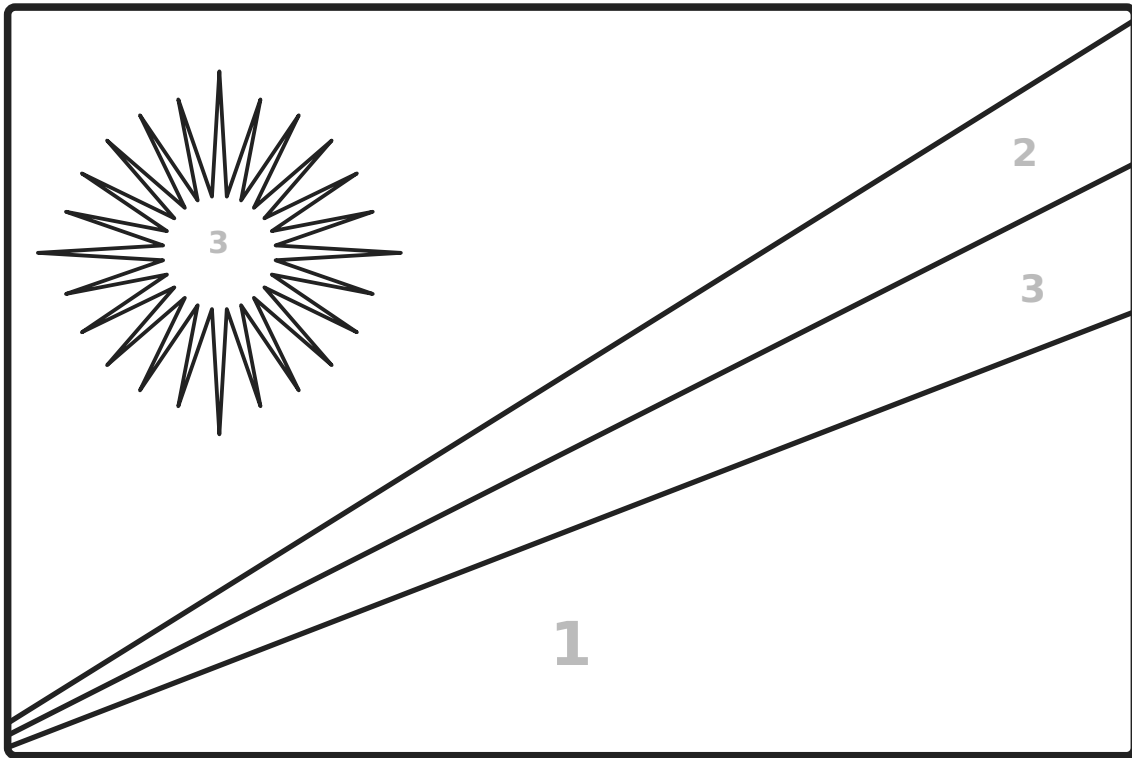


Marshall Islands Flag Colouring Page

COLOUR GUIDE

- 1**  **Blue** The background
- 2**  **Orange** The upper diagonal ray
- 3**  **White** The lower ray and the big star

DID YOU KNOW?

The big white **star** has 24 points — one for each of the country's electoral districts. The four longest points stand for the main cultural centres.

The two diagonal stripes stand for the **equator**. The **orange** ray means courage and the island group called Ratak (sunrise), and the **white** means peace and the Ralik group (sunset).

The Marshall Islands are made of **29 coral atolls** and 5 islands scattered across the Pacific Ocean — rings of tiny islands around calm blue lagoons.

The stripe getting wider as it rises stands for the islands lying just north of the **equator** and rising up out of the vast Pacific Ocean.
