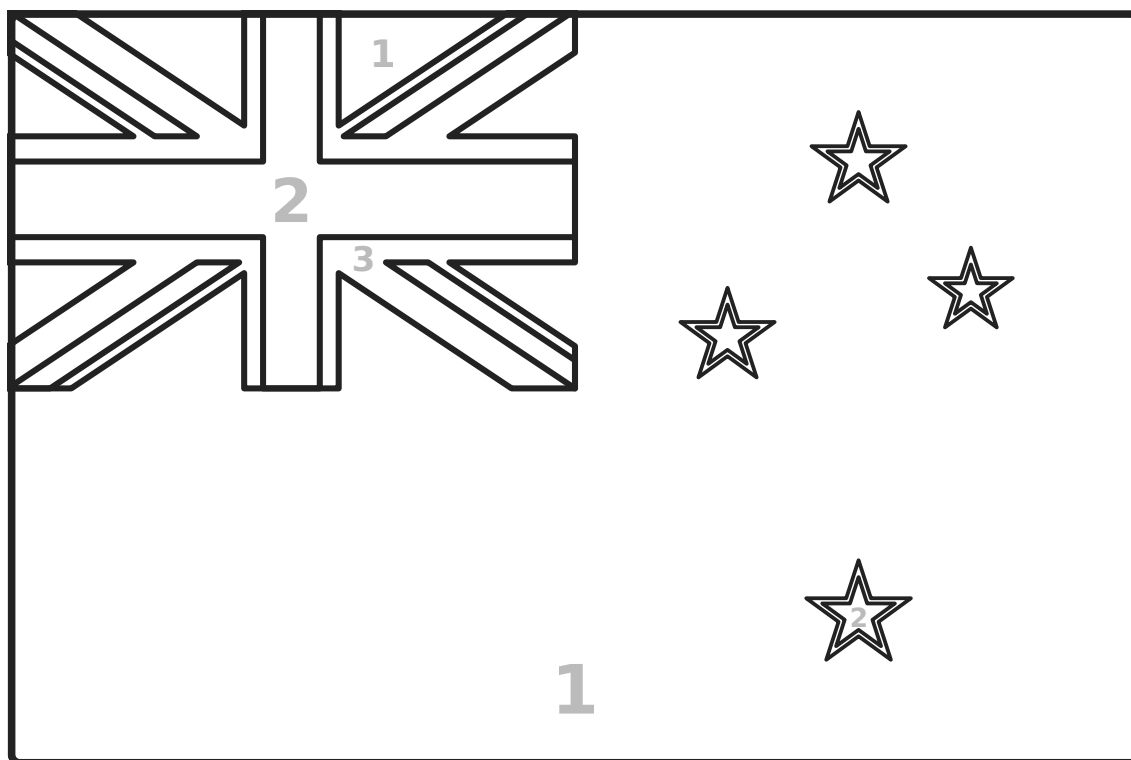


New Zealand Flag Colouring Page

COLOUR GUIDE

- 1**  **Dark blue** The whole background, and the corner sections inside the small flag
- 2**  **Red** The crosses inside the small flag, and all four stars
- 3**  **White** The bands around the red crosses, and the border around each star

DID YOU KNOW?

The four red stars are the **Southern Cross**, a constellation you can only see from the southern half of the world.

It's easy to mix up with Australia's flag. New Zealand has **four red stars with white borders**; Australia has **six white stars**, including a big one below the Union Jack.

New Zealand voted on whether to change this flag in **2015 and 2016** — after two referendums, people chose to keep it.

New Zealand's Māori name is **Aotearoa**, which is often translated as "land of the long white cloud".
