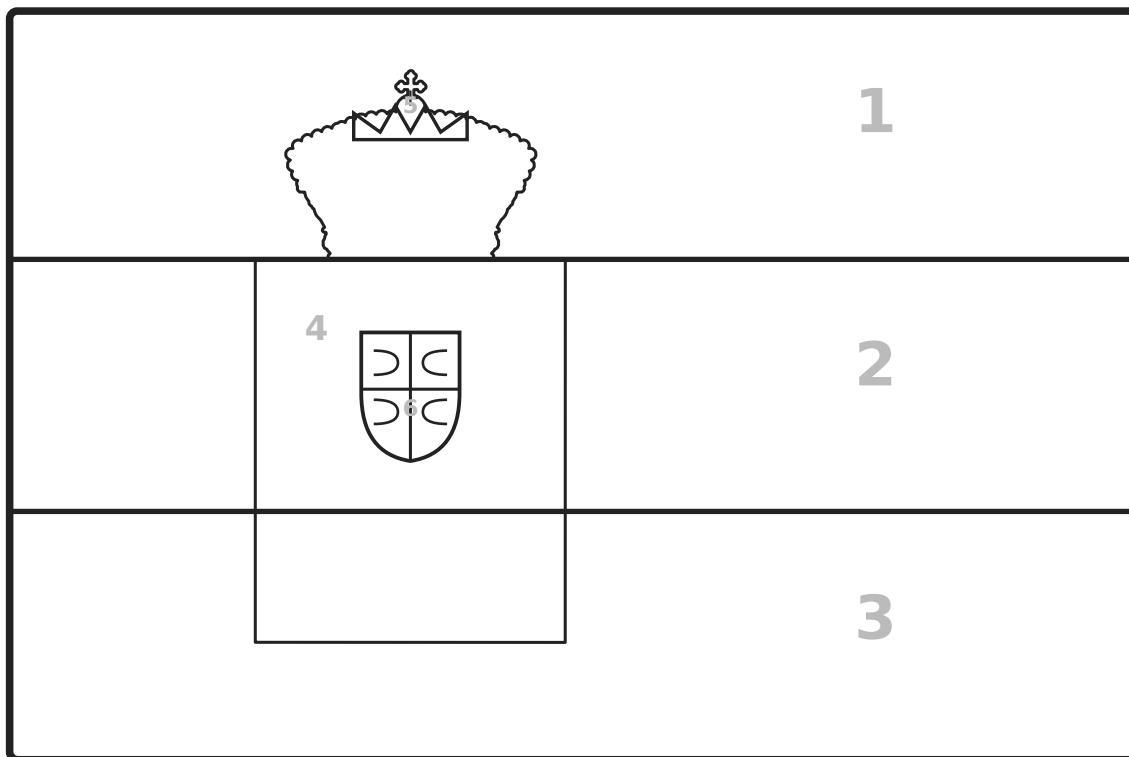


Serbia Flag Colouring Page

DID YOU KNOW?

The white bird is a **double-headed eagle** — an eagle with two heads looking in opposite directions. It's a very old royal symbol used across eastern Europe for hundreds of years.

On the eagle's chest is a red shield with a white cross and four shapes called **firesteels** (they were once used to make sparks). They stand for a Serbian saying about unity.

The **red, blue and white** stripes are the traditional Slavic colours, shared by several countries in the region like Russia and Slovakia.

Serbia is a country in south-east Europe. It's famous for being brilliant at **basketball, tennis and water polo** — the tennis champion Novak Djokovic is from Serbia.
