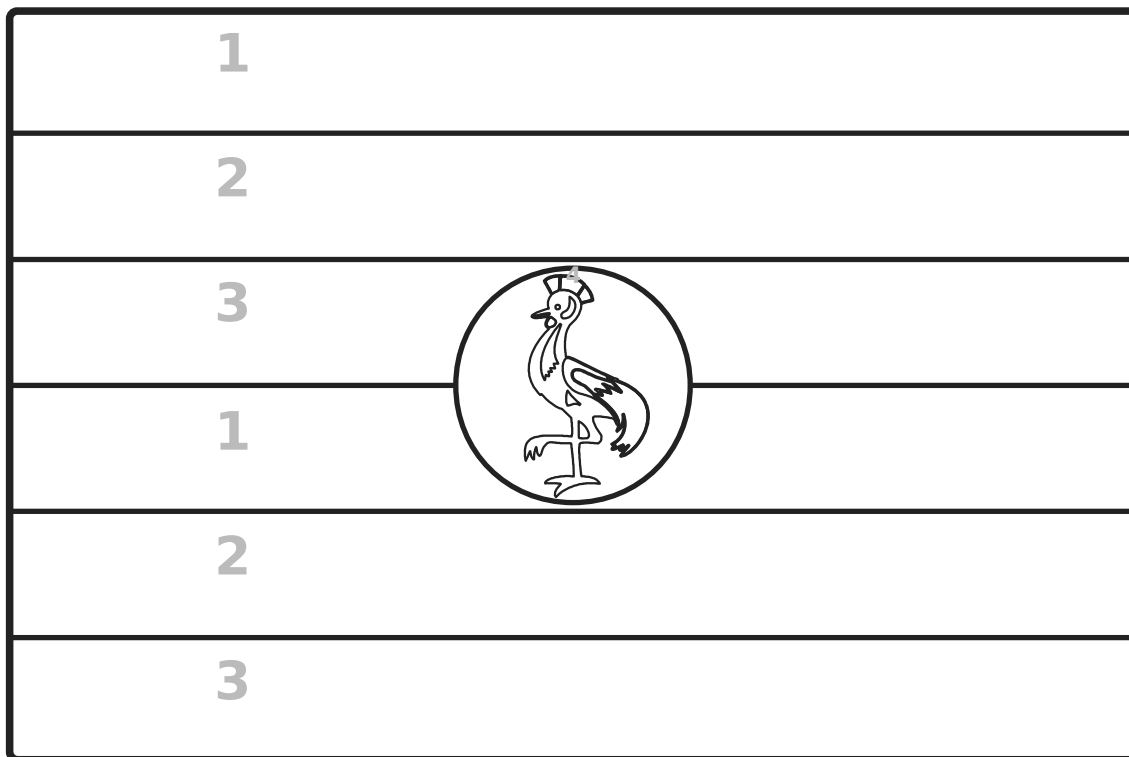


Uganda Flag Colouring Page

COLOUR GUIDE

- 1  **Black** The 1st, 4th stripes
- 2  **Yellow** The 2nd, 5th stripes
- 3  **Red** The 3rd, 6th stripes
- 4  **White** The circle in the middle

DID YOU KNOW?

The bird in the middle is a **grey crowned crane**, Uganda's national bird. It has a spiky golden crest on its head and stands tall on one leg.

Black stands for the people of Africa, **yellow** for the African sun, and **red** for the blood and brotherhood that connects all people.

The crane was chosen because it's a gentle bird that usually stands on one leg — just like it appeared on the flag of Uganda even before the country became independent in 1962.

Uganda is a country in East Africa often called the 'Pearl of Africa'. It's home to Lake Victoria, the source of the River Nile, and some of the last mountain gorillas in the world.
