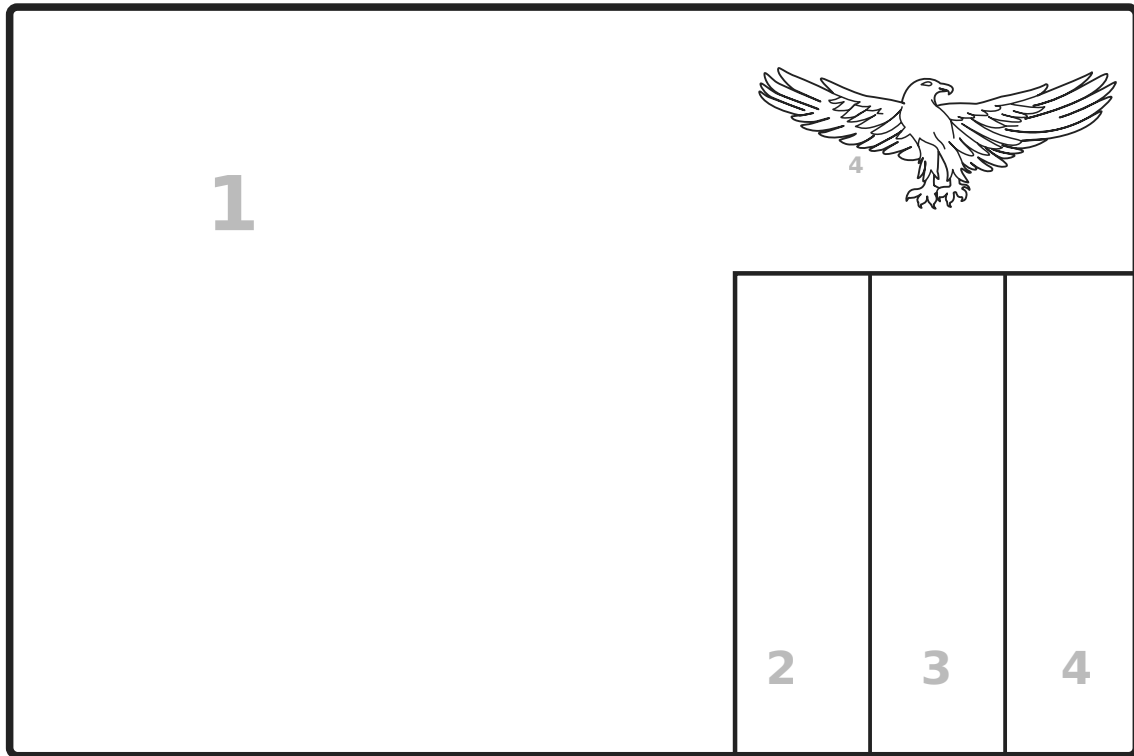


Zambia Flag Colouring Page

- 1  **Green** The main field
- 2  **Red** The 1st stripe
- 3  **Black** The 2nd stripe
- 4  **Orange** The 3rd stripe and the eagle

DID YOU KNOW?

The orange bird is an **African fish eagle**, flying free above the country. It stands for the people's freedom and their ability to rise above the nation's problems.

Green stands for Zambia's farms and forests, **red** for the struggle for freedom, **black** for the people of Zambia, and **orange** for the country's mineral wealth, especially copper.

Zambia's flag is unusual because the stripes and eagle sit in the **corner** rather than in the centre or along one edge, like many other flags.

Zambia is a country in southern Africa, home to Victoria Falls (shared with Zimbabwe) and the mighty Zambezi River, one of the longest rivers in Africa.
